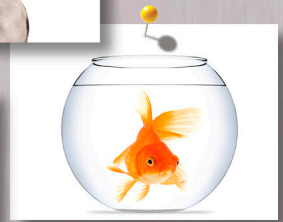
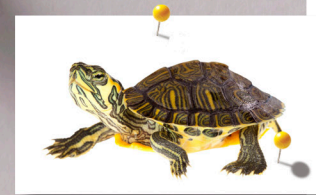


PETS IN FAMILIES PROJECT

The University of Denver Graduate School of Social Work* in collaboration with the Colorado Coalition Against Domestic Violence is conducting a study about families experiencing abuse and their pets. We are interested in learning how interactions with pets may be related to children's development.

The project will involve completing an interview and questionnaires (up to 2 hours). Child participants whose mothers have granted permission will also be interviewed and will complete questionnaires (up to 1 hour).

Mothers will receive \$60 for completing the surveys, and \$110 for participating again in 18 months. Children will receive \$15 both times they participate.
